Dear Students, Parents and Carers

Year 11 Arrangements for the end of GCSE Examinations

I am writing to communicate arrangements for students in Year 11 as the examination period draws to a close. From Wednesday 10 June, increasing numbers of students will have completed most of their examinations. As a result, we are amending our examination preparation provision.

This revised schedule provides students with focused revision sessions in school, and the opportunity to revise from home at other times. **For every morning examination, students should revise in school from 8:00.** Free toast is provided in the café from 7:45 until 8:00 and students can purchase other items.

Leavers' Day will take place on Wednesday 10 June, following the mathematics examination.

Please note that full uniform **must be worn** at all times. This includes either the leavers hoody **or** the school blazer.

Date	Examinations	Arrangements
Monday 8 June	Morning – Science Afternoon – Further Mathematics	All students are expected to be in school all day
Tuesday 9 June	Morning – Japanese and Spanish Afternoon – Construction	All students are expected to be in school all day. We are providing 2 hours of Mathematics revision lessons, 2 hours of Science revision lessons, and 1 hour of independent revision. There will be no revision sessions after school
Wednesday 10 June	Morning – Mathematics Afternoon – Greek	All students must attend the Mathematics examination. All students will then attend the leavers' assembly before leaving the school site with the exception of those who are sitting the Greek exam (see schedule below)
Thursday 11 June	Morning – Geography Afternoon – N/A	Geography students will attend the exam and then leave site. Other students will revise at home during the day for their remaining exams.
Friday 12 June	Morning – Science Afternoon – Portuguese, Persian, Hospitality and Catering, Dance	All students must attend the Science exam. With the exception of students sitting Portuguese, Persian, Hospitality and Catering, and Dance, students will then leave site. Students sitting afternoon exams will revise independently in the year base until their period 3 revision session.

- **10:45 to 11:20** – Students have a late break in the cafeteria and wait for the leavers' assembly; at 11:20, students move to the main hall. Students who have extra time in their examination will still have some time in the café before the leavers' assembly begins
- **11:20 to 12:00** – Leavers' assembly in the main hall
- **12:00 to 12:15** – All year 11 students to leave site

During the late break, students will receive their year books and have the opportunity to sign these and sign their school shirts for each other should they wish to do so.

I would like to thank our students for their conduct during the examinations this year. Their calm and organised approach and great attendance gives real hope for their performance in these exams, and they have set a good example to other students in school.

GCSE Results will be available on Thursday 20 August, from 9:00. Further details will be provided later in the summer term.
