## Year 9 Options and Subject Parents' and Carers' Evening – Thursday 12 February 2026

The Year 9 options evening is a significant event in the progression of your child through their secondary education; it allows your child to explore the range of subjects on offer to support their future aspirations. As this is a key transition point, we would like to provide you and your child with the best opportunity to gain insights into what options are available, along with details of your child's progress in core subjects. We are therefore organising an in-person parents' and carers' evening.

The in-person event will involve a presentation explaining the options process and the timeline for submitting option choices, and the opportunity for you and your child to explore option subjects. You will also be able to attend parents' evening appointments with your child's **English, Mathematics and Science** teachers. Some students who receive support from our SEND department may also have the option to book an appointment with either our SENDCO or one of the Assistant SENDCOs. These appointments will be booked via SchoolCloud.

Due to the large number of students and parents attending the evening, it will be split into two sessions. You have been grouped in session 2 (students with a surname beginning M – Z), which has an arrival time of 5pm, with a presentation in the main hall at 5.05pm. The presentation will explain in further detail the options process and the timeline for students and options selection. A schedule for the evening can be found below:
