Dear Parents and Carers

I want to begin this week's letter by praising your children for the way they have worked with us in bringing improvements to our school since the start of term. The school feels really settled and purposeful – you would be welcome to visit to see for yourselves. Students in year 7, of course, have never known anything different. Older students have cooperated well with the changes. Our corridors are busy at the changeover of lessons; but corridors are orderly, and students now get to lessons on time. Our habits of attention ('STAR') and, where appropriate, silent independent work, are bringing increased focus and purpose to classrooms. Students tell us that they value these changes, because they help them to make the most of lesson time and improve their learning.

Next Thursday, 28 September, is our Year 6 Open Evening. If you have visited our school recently, you will have seen our eye-catching banner at the gate. Our Open Evening is very popular, and we run it twice on the same evening. Thank you in advance to the many students who will volunteer their time as tour guides and within subject areas. To ease traffic congestion, this year we are asking everyone to turn left out of the school grounds onto Birtley Lane: you will not be able to turn right as you leave the school gates.

Our Open Evening is a wonderful occasion for primary school pupils and their parents/carers to see our school in action. I know that many of you will be there if you have children in Year 6 currently. We have much to celebrate: we know that our facilities are excellent, and that the school provides a very good standard of education to all its students. As Lord Lawson continues to improve, we are sure that our school will be even more popular. We intend to keep the school at around its present size, however, since this gives all students a chance to know one another and to feel that they are known as individuals. This will be our first Open Evening since we were judged 'Good' in all areas by Ofsted. Please tell your wider family and friends – personal recommendation and word-of-mouth are by far the best publicity!

We have been notified of industrial action by bus drivers later this term. Some of you may already have heard about this. At present, we are waiting to hear the extent of the disruption, and we do not yet know whether we will be affected by it. As soon as I have any firm details, I will let you know.

At their meeting on Wednesday, Governors heard with interest about the work we are doing this year to form closer partnerships with parents and carers. Governors committed themselves and our school to improving communication, to making sure the school is always a welcoming place, and to inviting parents and carers into school more regularly, so you can feel more part of our community and be well informed about the ways in which your children learn.

One great opportunity to come into school and enjoy seeing our students demonstrate their performing skills is our show, *Shrek The Musical, Jr*. This is an entertaining family show, full of interesting songs and lovable characters. It is particularly suitable for our large and talented cast, which includes Year 7 students, even though they have only been here for 3 weeks. *Shrek* runs from Tuesday 24 to Friday 27 October. Tickets will go on sale soon.
