

Pathways to the Professions 2024 Applications Are Now Open!

Our Pathways programmes support disadvantaged students in Year 12 – 13 to explore career opportunities in Banking and Finance (both in-person and online), Consulting (online), Engineering (in-person), Law (in-person and online), Medicine (in-person), and Veterinary Medicine (hybrid) for free.

Far too often these careers require professional connections, the ability to take on unpaid internships, and/or soft skills which aren't taught at schools in order to break in. Our Pathways programmes bridge that gap for disadvantaged students by offering UK Summer Schools – these are residential summer schools at leading universities where you can experience university and student life.

In addition, for those considering apprenticeships, The Apprenticeship Summer School is a 3-day residential at the University of Warwick designed to increase awareness of degree-level apprenticeships and equip you with the skills to navigate the apprenticeship landscape.

These summer schools are FREE and are a fantastic way of exploring universities or apprenticeships during your summer break.
