**Skills and knowledge – you need:**

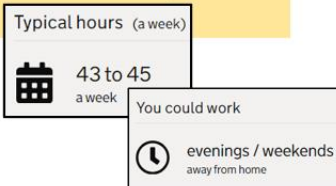
- to be thorough and pay attention to detail

Useful courses at college include Construction, Carpentry and Join Plumbing, Fitted Interiors

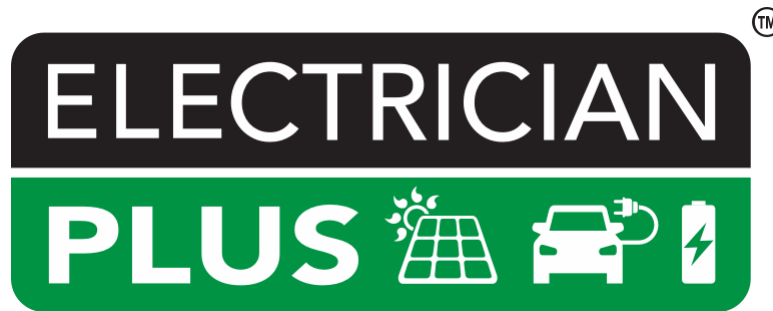
