Entry Requirements

Audit Apprenticeships: 5 GCSEs 4 – 9 (inc. English Language and Maths at Grade B or 5), or for Scotland 5 National 5 qualifications at Grades A – C (inc. English Language and Maths at Grade B or equivalent) and 120 UCAS points (from any subjects excluding General Studies).
