Just be open to any opportunities. Be helpful and kind. Take notes at the end of each day.

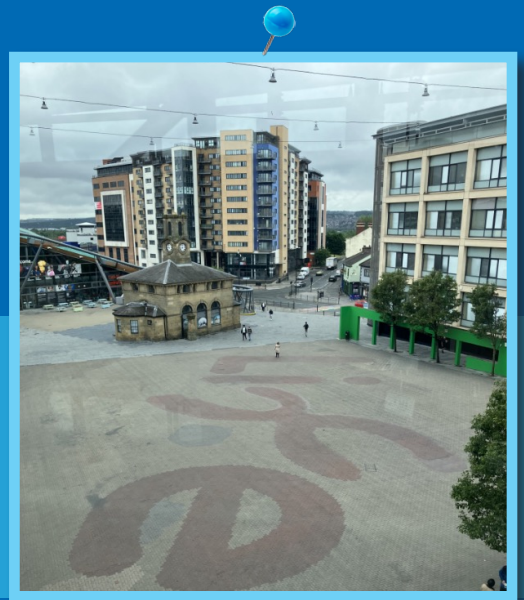
